Jesus crucified at 9am
(**Mat.26:19-20**)
Jesus dies at 3pm

Buried by sundown
(beginning of 'high day'
John 19:31 – the 15th
Lev.23:5-6)

THURSDAY

High Sabbath Day
Feast of Unleavened
Bread
no work can be done

sundown begins the 16th

FRIDAY

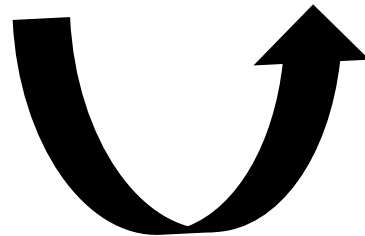
Preparation Day
(*work can be done*)

women purchase
spices (*after Sabbath
according to **Mark 16:1**,
and before Sabbath
according to **Luke 22:55-56***)

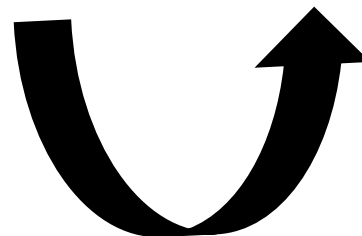
SATURDAY

Regular Sabbath Day

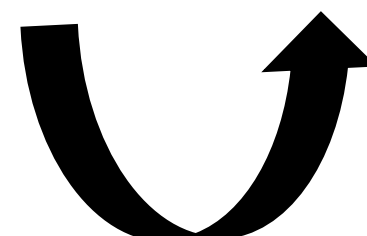
Jesus resurrects after
sundown! (17th)



1st night and day



2nd night and day



3rd night and day

Matthew 12:40 – “For as Jonah was in the belly of the huge fish three days and three nights, so the Son of Man will be in the heart of the earth three days and three nights.”

Genesis 1:5 – tells us that a day begins with the evening.

Matthew 28:1 – “After the Sabbath, as the first day of the week was dawning, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to the view the tomb.”

The word ‘Sabbath’ here is more properly interpreted, ‘Sabbaths’ (**sabbaton** = gen plural neutral of the word)
